The Alliance of Wound Care Stakeholders (“Alliance”) is pleased to submit the attached PQRI quality measure for adequate off-loading of neuropathic diabetic foot ulcers. The Alliance is a 501 (c) (6) multidisciplinary trade association consisting of 19 physician, clinical, provider, and patient organizations, whose mission is to promote quality care and patient access to wound care products and services. This measure was written with the advice of Alliance organizations that not only possess expert knowledge in complex acute and chronic wounds, but also in wound care and research. The candidate measure is in the **Public Domain** and has been developed based on national practice guidelines.
